In 1996, DBU began a special scholarship program designed to partner with churches to help outstanding students from their congregations. That year, DBU was able to provide up to \$500 per academic year in matching funds. Dr. Gary Cook felt that the churches would know which students deserved and needed the scholarships best. Over the years, more and more churches have participated in this program, and DBU has been able to raise its amount of matching funds to \$3,000 per academic year.

Five years ago, Dr. Cook was praying about the direction and the future plans for DBU when the Lord laid something on his heart—The Global Village. Although Dr. Cook felt that there were more pressing needs for the school, he knew that he should respond to the prompting of God and begin to raise funds and establish this new section of the DBU campus. The Global Village houses two apartment complexes, Fred and Mary Lou White Hall and Sheila Cook Hall, the David and In Sun Moon International Center, and the Jeannette and Cletys Sadler Global Missions Center.

Inside the two apartment buildings, international and American students are teamed up, providing rich cultural experiences as well as unique opportunities to study the Bible and share the Gospel. The Moon International Center has classroom space for the Intensive English Program, as well as the offices for International Student Services. Inside the Sadler Global Missions Center is housed the DBU Baptist Student Ministry, Spiritual Life Office, Student Affairs, and also the International Admissions Office, as well as the offices for DBU's Master of Arts in Global Leadership degree.



## Athletes Go Global-

Beginning in 2007, DBU launched a new program allowing for student athletes to participate in mission trips while also gaining international competition experiences. Since its inception, the Global Sports Mission Initiative has seen every DBU athletic team travel in two trips to locations in Africa, Asia, Central America, the Caribbean, Europe, and South America.
