The Patriot Basketball team finished the 2007-08 season with a 17-16 overall record and a 5-5 Heartland Conference record, including a second consecutive trip to the conference playoffs as well as the National Christian College Athletics Association national tournament.

"It has been an exciting year," explained Head Coach Blake Flickner. "To be in only our second year of NCAA competition and to have won 17 games this year is exceptional. I think it gives us a solid foundation to continue to build upon for the future."

The Patriots, who won eight straight games and I2 of their final I4 contests, suffered a double-overtime loss in the Heartland Conference playoffs to St. Edward's University, who went on to win the tournament.

Following the Heartland Tournament, DBU won the NCCAA Central Region Championship and headed to Indiana for the NCCAA National Tournament. Although losing to eventual champion, Indiana Wesleyan, the Patriots bounced back and won their final game, securing a third place national finish.
