DR. FRED WHITE

The Dallas Baptist University family mourns the passing of Dr. Fred White. One of the founders of the institution and its strongest supporter over the years, Dr. White embodied a life of servant leadership and devotion to the Kingdom of God. He was born on January 3, 1913, and passed away on October 9, 2006, at the age of 93.

A native Texan, White served in numerous churches prior to being called as pastor of First Baptist Church of Duncanville in 1948. In 1955 he was named pastor of First Baptist Church of Carrollton.

Beginning in the early 1960s, Dr. White and other Baptist leaders in the Dallas area began to explore ways in which to begin a Baptist university in the Dallas area. In 1963, the leaders approached Decatur Baptist College (established in 1898) to inquire about moving the college to a new location in southwest Dallas. The Decatur leadership agreed, and in 1965 the doors opened at Dallas Baptist College.

The original freshman class in 1965 was recruited by Dr. White, who was appointed as chairman of the religion and philosophy department, the forerunner of today's Mary C. Crowley College of Christian Faith. In addition to his role as professor, he also served in various administrative roles, including twice being named as interim president.

In 1985, Dr. White officially retired from full-time service at DBU, but his presence never left the campus. He maintained an office on campus and continued to work as a distinguished adjunct professor of Christian faith until he fully retired in 2002.

Dr. Fred White was preceded in death by his son, Fred, Jr., and his wife of 67 years, Mary Lou, who passed away in 2005. He is survived by his son and daughter-in-law, Dr. Bill and Vicki White, and his daughter, Mary Helen Atkins, as well as three grandchildren and four great-grandchildren.
